The band's music includes many well-known songs from the swing era during the days of famous band leaders like Benny Goodman, Harry James, and Glenn Miller. Sean Nelson joined the band as music director in March 2016. Mr. Nelson is a trombonist in the U. S. Coast Guard band, staff arranger, a member of the Coast Guard Dixieland Band, and Music Director of the Guardians Big Band.
