## 8. A BY-LAW PROHIBITING INJURING OR LIGHTING PUBLIC LAMPS (MAY 26, 1904)

Any person who shall maliciously cut, break, injure, destroy, or deface any public lamp, lantern, lamp post or frame in said city, or light any public lamp without proper authority or extinguish the same, or in any way interfere or meddle with the proper use or management of the public lamps or lights of said city, shall pay a fine of not more than twenty dollars to the city treasury.
