# 54. ORDINANCE RELATIVE TO WATER RATE REVISIONS – 1983 FOR THE CITY OF GROTON, DEPARTMENT OF UTILITIES, WATER CUSTOMERS (OCTOBER 3, 1983)

WHEREAS, the City of Groton Water Department requires additional revenues to cover increased operating costs; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Groton Utilities Commission on August 18, 1983, conducted a Public Hearing on the proposed water rate revision, and have considered all comments presented thereat; and

WHEREAS, the City of Groton Utilities Commissioners have arrived at a revised water rate schedule after careful consideration; and

**WHEREAS**, on August 18, 1983, at a regular meeting, the City of Groton Utilities Commissioners approved the Water Rate Revisions 1983, and have recommended adoption of same by the City Council;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** to initially approve the City of Groton, Department of Utilities, Water Rate Revisions - 1983, to be effective on October 1, 1983, and July 1, 1984, and thereafter until revised.

### RATE SCHEDULE FOR WATER SERVICE RENDERED ON AND AFTER JULY 1, 1984

#### **AVAILABILITY**

- 1. To property owners, or their duly authorized agents, who have an approved water service(s) to serve each single or multifamily dwelling, business, or industrial establishment.
- 2. To non-property owners for temporary use by a contractor, circus, carnival, or anyone else for similar temporary use, either from a service or hydrant, providing all rules of this Department have been met.
