BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROTON:

Section 1. Consistent with the recommendation of the City of Groton Utility Commission and the approval of the City of Groton Planning and Zoning Commission, the expenditure of \$7,869,500 for the following estimated costs of the City of Groton Department of Utilities 2000 Electric Bond Fund Program which will provide for improvements to the City’s electric system is hereby approved.




