The City of Groton Police Department is sponsoring a Citizens Police Academy. Applicants must be 21 years of age and either reside or work full time within the City of Groton. Background investigations will be conducted on all applicants. Applicants must not have been convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, or have any pending criminal cases. Class size is limited. Selected applicants will be notified by email.

Classes will begin on April 17, 2019 and continue on Wednesdays, for 8 weeks. Graduation is scheduled for June 12, 2019. Participants may not miss more than one class during the session. All classes will be held at the City of Groton Municipal Building Auditorium, from 6:30 pm-9:00 pm.

All applications must be received to the City of Groton Police Department no later than 4:00 pm on Friday, March, 29, 2019.
