

142. AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF UTILITIES 2002 ELECTRIC BOND FUND PROGRAM

**(INITIALLY APPROVED JULY 1, 2002;
FINALLY APPROVED AUGUST 5, 2002)**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROTON:

Section 1. Consistent with the recommendation of the City of Groton Utility Commission and the approval of the City of Groton Planning and Zoning Commission, the expenditure of \$4,840,000 for the following projects of the City of Groton Department of Utilities 2002 Electric Bond Fund Program, which will provide for improvements to the City's electric system, is hereby approved.

1. Pole Line Extension on Drozdyk Drive
2. Installation of UG 35 kV Duct Bank on Drozdyk Drive
3. Municipal Building Electrical Service Upgrade
4. Buddington Substation Modifications
5. Additional Power Transformer for Buddington Substation
6. Upgrades to Transmission Lines (69 kV to 115 kV)

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage.

WHEREAS, the City of Groton Mayor and Council initially approved this Ordinance at their meeting held on July 1, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the initial approval of this Ordinance was published in *The Day*, a newspaper having circulation in the City of Groton on July 5, 2002 and July 6, 2002; and


