

134. **ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 122 AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF UTILITIES TELECOMMUNICATIONS BOND FUND PROGRAM**

**(INITIALLY APPROVED JUNE 4, 2001;
FINALLY APPROVED JULY 2, 2001)**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROTON:

“**Section 1.** The sum of \$6,900,000 is appropriated for the planning, design, construction, and installation of a Hybrid Fiber Coaxial (HFC) network, electronic equipment, PBX telephone equipment, internet service provider services and the planning, design, construction, installation, and testing of all facilities and equipment associated with a Community antenna television system to provide Community antenna television services, as defined in the Connecticut General Statutes, and internet provider services (collectively “the Project”), including without limitation, the preparation of feasibility studies and preliminary plans and specifications, and applications for all necessary regulatory approvals for the Project, the Municipal Building Design Build of the control room and offices, and construction related to items for the Project, including without limitation, make ready work, acquisition of all rights-of-way and the obtaining of all regulatory approvals and authorizations, associated control room and offices, and acquisition of required vehicles; and for administrative, printing, legal, consulting, and financing costs related thereto.”

Total Estimated Cost \$6,900,000

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council **initially** approved the amendment to this Ordinance at a Mayor and Council meeting held on June 4, 2001; and

WHEREAS, the City of Groton Utility Commission approved the amendment to this Ordinance at a Special Meeting held on June 5, 2001; and

WHEREAS, this amendment was published in *The Day*, a newspaper having circulation in the City of Groton, on June 8, 2001 and June 9, 2001; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance (Ordinance #134) shall take effect upon passage.


