**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF

Section 1. Consistent with the recommendation of the City of Groton Utility Commission and the approval of the City of Groton Planning and Zoning Commission, the expenditure of \$2,629,000 for the following estimated costs of the City of Groton Department of Utilities 2000 Water Bond Fund Program which will provide for the development and improvement of the City's water supply, storage, treatment and distribution facilities is hereby approved.

WHEREAS, this Ordinance was initially approved at the Mayor and Council meeting held on July 17, 2000; and


