

**131. “AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF UTILITIES 2001 ELECTRIC BOND FUND PROGRAM” (INITIALLY APPROVED MARCH 7, 2001; FREEMAN’S MEETING APRIL 2, 2001; FINALLY APPROVED APRIL 2, 2001)**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROTON:**

**Section 1.** Consistent with the recommendation of the City of Groton Utility Commission and the approval of the City of Groton Planning and Zoning Commission, the expenditure of \$11,897,000 for the following estimated costs of the City of Groton Department of Utilities 2001 Electric Bond Fund Program that will provide for improvements to the City’s electric system is hereby approved.

1. Rebuild of Poquonnock River Substation	\$ 5,802,000
2. Re-conductor 304/309 lines	308,000
3. Construct 339 line	1,457,000
4. Trails Corner Substation Distribution feeder voltage conversion	1,912,000
5. Poquonnock River Substation Distribution feeder voltage conversion	866,000
6. Upgrade the 300/305 lines	340,000
7. Disposal of the 303/308 lines	322,000
8. Long Hill Substation Distribution feeder voltage conversion	695,000
9. Retirement of Long Hill Substation	<u>195,000</u>
	Total Estimated Cost <u>\$11,897,000</u>


