

# ORDINANCE 122 AMENDED BY ORDINANCE 134

## 122. AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF UTILITIES TELECOMMUNICATIONS BOND FUND PROGRAM (DECEMBER 6, 1999)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROTON:

Section 1. Consistent with the recommendation of the City of Groton Utility Commission and the approval of the City of Groton Planning and Zoning Commission, the expenditure of \$6,900,000 for the cost of the Telecommunications Bond Fund Program which will provide for the planning, design, construction and installation of a telecommunications network, is hereby approved.

Section 2. This Ordinance (Ordinance #122) shall take effect upon passage.

**WHEREAS**, the Planning and Zoning Commission, at its regular meeting held on November 16, 1999 voted to approve the Department of Utilities Telecommunications Bond Fund Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Groton Utility Commissioners, at a special meeting held on October 29, 1999 considered and voted unanimously to approve a proposed Telecommunications Bond Fund Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the electors and qualified citizens of the City of Groton approved this Ordinance at a Special City of Groton Freeman’s meeting held on December 6, 1999; and


