

ORDINANCE 92 SUPERCEDED BY ORDINANCE 113

92. ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 74A “ORDINANCE CONCERNING EXPENDITURES FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF UTILITIES 1989 WATER BOND FUND PROGRAM”

(JANUARY 3, 1994)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROTON:

Section 1. Phase III of Section 1 of the Ordinance entitled “An Ordinance Concerning Expenditures For the Department of Utilities 1989 Water Bond Fund Program,” approved by the Mayor and Council of the City on September 5, 1989, is hereby amended by deleting said Phase III and substituting the following in lieu thereof:

“PHASE III

DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM

3.1 Route 1 and Route 215 Water Main Extension to Proposed Fort Hill Standpipe	\$50,000
3.2 Fort Hill Water Storage Tank	550,000
3.3 Route 1 Water Main, Fort Hill Tank to Depot Road	900,000
3.4 Land Acquisition, Acquisition of Bel Aire System, Legal, Environment, Business Valuation, Appraisal and Contingencies	1,131,000
3.5 Route 1 Main to Bel Aire Section	550,000
3.6 System Upgrades to Bel Aire	300,000
3.7 Distribution System Expansion to Other Customers in Area Including Meters	<u>350,000</u>
Total Estimated Cost, Phase III	\$3,831,000”

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Section 2. This Ordinance (Ordinance 92) shall take effect upon passage.
