

**25. AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING CERTAIN ACTS OF NUISANCE  
(MAY 26, 1904)**

The following acts, when committed within said city, are declared to be acts of nuisance, to wit: The keeping of swine in any sty or other place in such manner that the same shall become unwholesome or offensive to any person; the causing or permitting the accumulation in any building, outhouse, yard, or enclosure, of any filth, manure, offal, waste, dirty water, or brine, which shall become offensive to any person; the setting up or continuing of any privy, barn, stable, hog pen, or slaughter house, in such manner that the same shall become unwholesome or offensive to any person; the causing or permitting wash or dirty water to pass from yards or houses through drains, sewers, gutters, or otherwise into any street or sidewalk of said city; the depositing of filth, offal, garbage, ashes or rubbish in any of the streets or public grounds in said city; and the throwing or depositing any dead animal in any waters contained within or contiguous to the city, or in any reservoir from which water is drawn, or any street, sidewalk, public grounds or vacant lot in said city; and any person doing or committing any of said acts, or who shall aid or assist in the commissions of the same, shall forfeit and pay a fine not exceeding twenty dollars, and not less than one dollar for each offense; and each day's continuance of any nuisance hereinbefore mentioned shall constitute a separate and distinct offense.
