

**1. BY-LAW CONCERNING MOVING BUILDINGS**  
**(MAY 26, 1904)**

No person shall remove, or draw through or upon any street in said city, any building or part thereof without the consent of the mayor and council upon written application therefor.

Every application under this section shall state the name of the owner of the building to be moved, the name of the person who is to move the same, the precise locality from whence the building is to be moved and the precise locality to which it is to be removed, the distance from the proposed front line of such building to the line of the street, the street or streets through which it is to be conveyed, the dimensions and condition of the building, and the nature of the materials of which it is constructed, and every application under this section shall be carefully filed and preserved.

No person receiving permission to remove a building as provided for in this section shall be deemed to have permission to remove the same through or upon any street not designated in said application or permit.
