

236. AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$7,470,000 AND AUTHORIZING ITS EXPENDITURE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF UTILITIES FOR THE 2020-2021 WATER BOND FUND PROGRAM’ (INITIALLY APPROVED FEBRUARY 1, 2021; FINALLY APPROVED MARCH 1, 2021)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROTON:

Consistent with the recommendation of the Commissioners of the City of Groton Department of Utilities, the sum of \$7,470,000 is appropriated and authorized to be expended by the Department of Utilities for the costs of the 2020-2021 Water Bond Fund Program, which will provide upgrades to the distribution system, including, but not limited to, water main replacement for various portions of the service territory, water meters, the replacement of the Brandegee Avenue Standpipe, the low lift pump station screening and manganese abatement project, and for engineering, administrative, printing, legal and financings costs related thereto.

THEREFORE, BE IT BE RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council **finally** approve “an Ordinance appropriating \$7,470,000 and authorizing its expenditure by the Department of Utilities for the 2020-2021 Water Bond Fund Program.”
