

**225. AN “ORDINANCE DESIGNATING THE CITY OF GROTON UTILITIES COMMISSION AS THE WATER POLLUTION CONTROL AUTHORITY” (INITIALLY APPROVED MARCH 5, 2018; FINALLY APPROVED APRIL 2, 2018)**

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Groton at a regular meeting thereof duly held on April 2, 2018:

Section 1 - Ordinance 34 and Ordinance 44 are hereby rescinded.

Section 2 - Pursuant to the provisions of Section 7-246 of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended to date, the City of Groton Utilities Commission is hereby designated as the Water Pollution Control Authority for the City of Groton with all of the powers and duties of a Water Pollution Control Authority pursuant to all applicable state statutes, as from time to time amended, including, without limitation, (i) the authority to establish and revise rules and regulations for the supervision, management, control, operation and use of the City’s sanitary sewage system and for the transaction of its business, and (ii) the authority to establish and revise fair and reasonable charges for connection with and for the use of the City’s sanitary sewage system.

Section 3 - This Ordinance shall be effective upon adoption by the City Council.

**WHEREAS**, this Ordinance was published in The Day, a newspaper having general circulation in the City of Groton on March 9, 2018 and March 10, 2018;

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Mayor and Council Finally Approve “An Ordinance Designating the City of Groton Utilities Commission as the Water Pollution Control Authority”
