

**213. AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$5,525,000 AND AUTHORIZING ITS EXPENDITURE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF UTILITIES FOR THE 2015-2016 WATER BOND FUND PROGRAM AND PENDING THE ISSUANCE THEREOF THE MAKING OF TEMPORARY BORROWINGS FOR SUCH PURPOSE AND RESCINDS R-15-9-129 (INITIALLY APPROVE AUGUST 3, 2015; FINALLY APPROVED SEPTEMBER 8, 2015)**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROTON:


Consistent with the recommendation of the Commissioners of the City of Groton Department of Utilities, the sum of \$5,525,000 is appropriated and authorized to be expended by the Department of Utilities for the costs of the 2015-2016 Water Bond Fund Program which will provide for improvements to the City of Groton Water System, and for engineering, administrative, printing, legal and financings costs related thereto as follows:

Walker Hill Standpipe Replacement	\$3,500,000
Meter Replacement	<u>2,025,000</u>
Total	<u><u>\$5,525,000</u></u>
