

**211. AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$1,284,209 AND AUTHORIZING ITS EXPENDITURE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF UTILITIES FOR THE 2015-2016 ELECTRIC BOND FUND PROGRAM (BOZRAH LIGHT POWER)
(INITIALLY APPROVED AUGUST 3, 2015; FINALLY APPROVED SEPTEMBER 8, 2015)**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROTON:

Consistent with the recommendation of the Commissioners of the City of Groton Department of Utilities, the sum of \$1,284,209 is appropriated and authorized to be expended by the Department of Utilities for the costs of the 2015-2016 Electric Bond Fund Program which will provide for improvements to Bozrah Light and Power, and for engineering, administrative, printing, legal and financings costs related thereto as follows:


Bishop Road Reconductor	\$673,724

SCADA - Device Installation and Upgrade	<u>81,599</u>
Total	<u>\$1,284,209</u>
