

172. AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$8,500,000.00 AND AUTHORIZING ITS EXPENDITURE BY THE DEPARTMENT OF UTILITIES FOR THE 2008 CABLE TELEVISION AND INTERNET SERVICE BOND FUND PROGRAM” (INITIALLY APPROVED APRIL 7, 2008; FINALLY APPROVED MAY 5, 2008)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GROTON:

Section 1. Consistent with the recommendation of the Commissioners of the City of Groton Department of Utilities, the sum of Eight Million, Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$8,500,000.00) is appropriated and authorized to be expended by the Department of Utilities for the costs of the 2008 Cable Television and Internet Services Bond Fund Program which will provide for the planning, acquisition and construction of extensions and improvements to the Thames Valley Communications, Inc. community antenna television system and internet services network, and for administrative, printing, legal and financing costs related thereto.


Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage.
