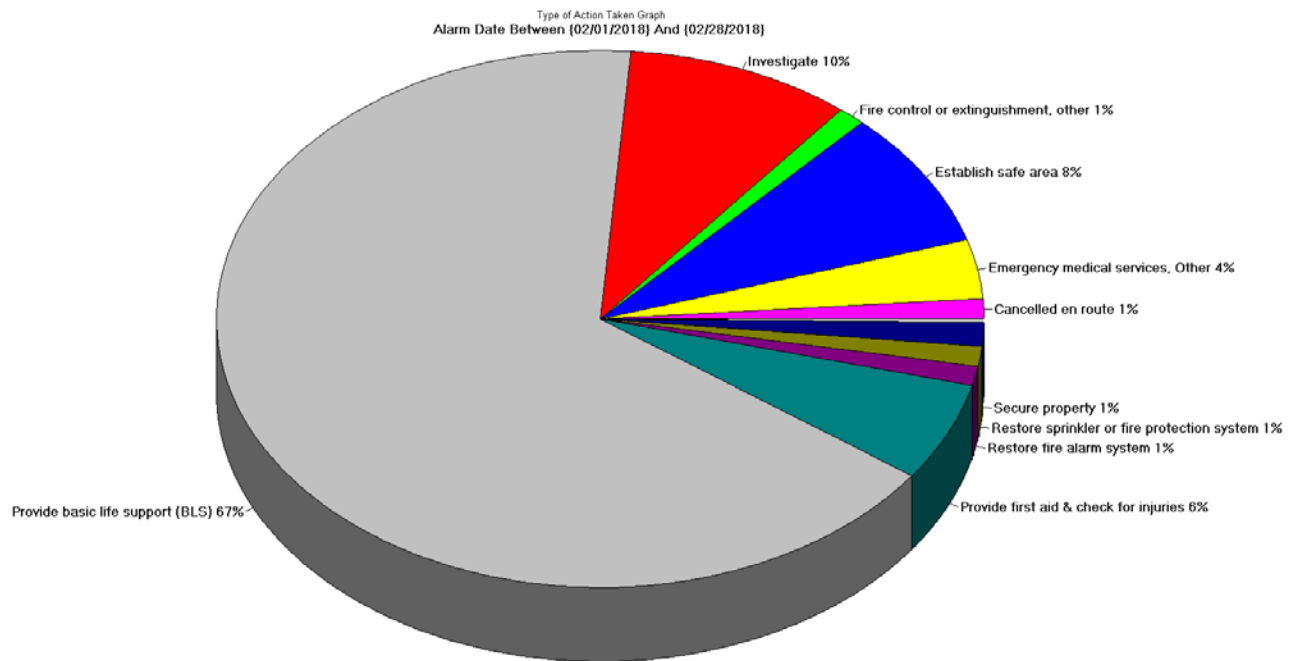

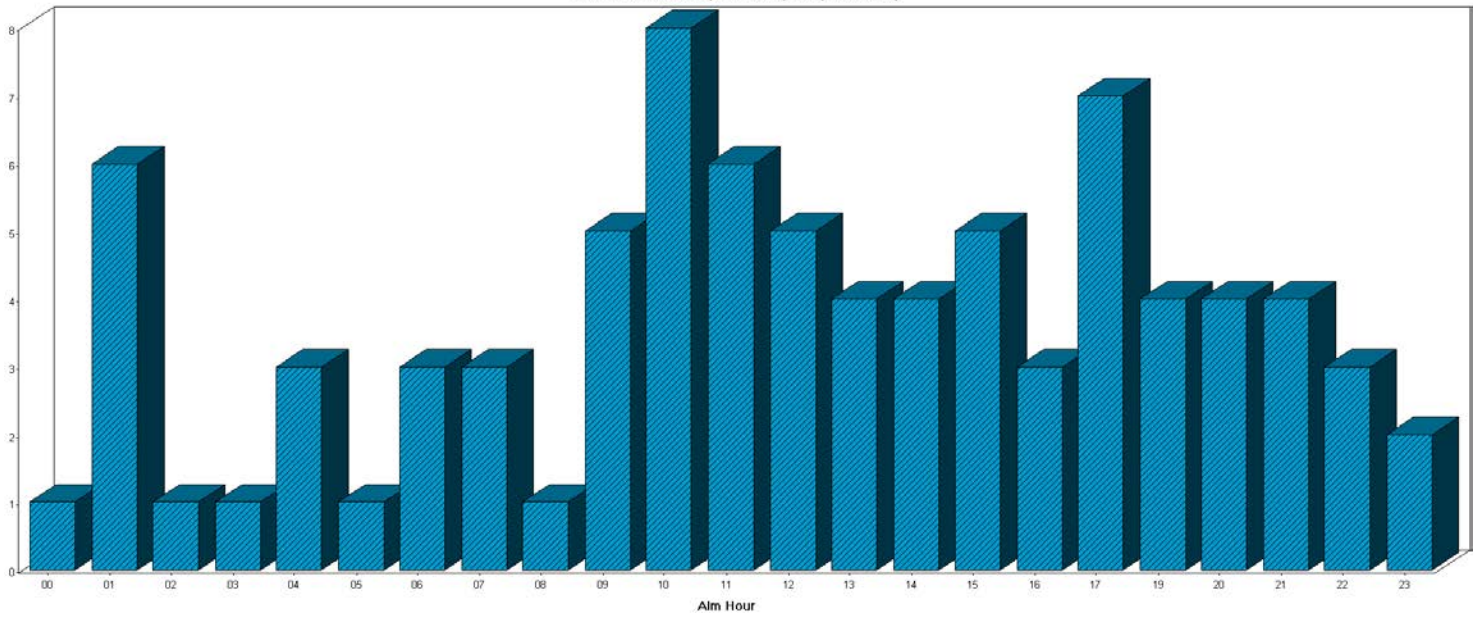
- 1) GCFD personnel participated in rehearsal for Milstone Radiological Emergency Drill in March .

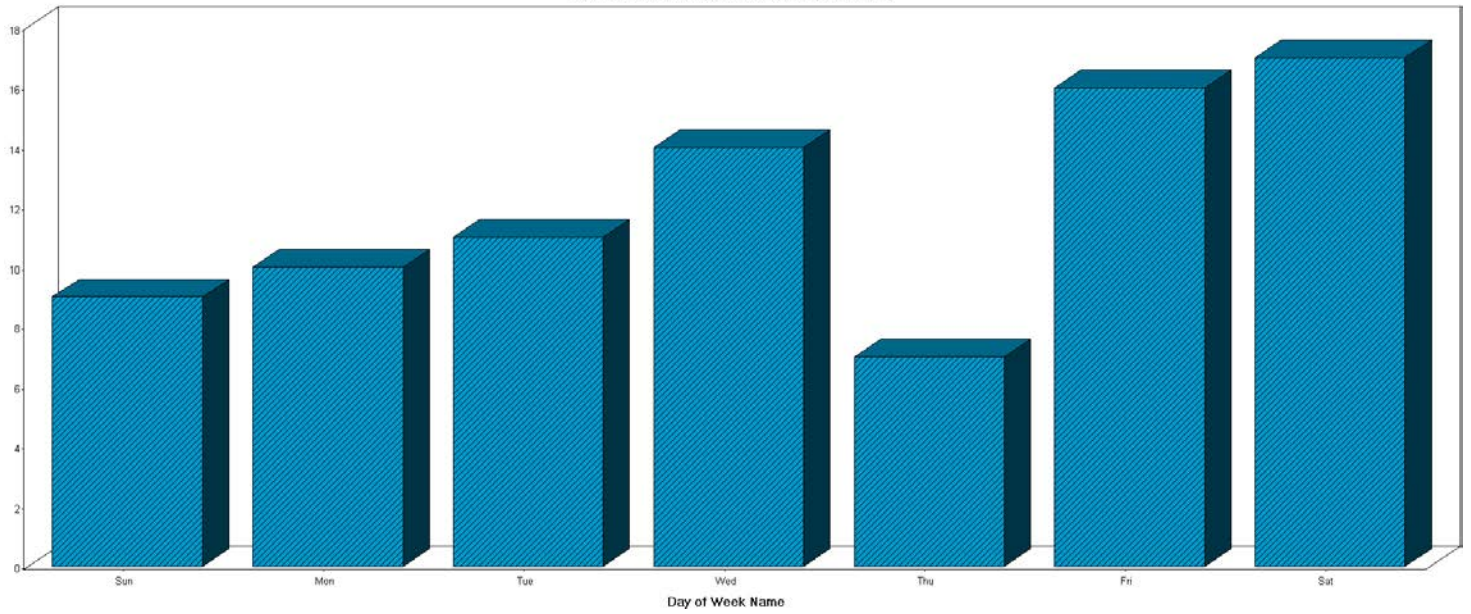

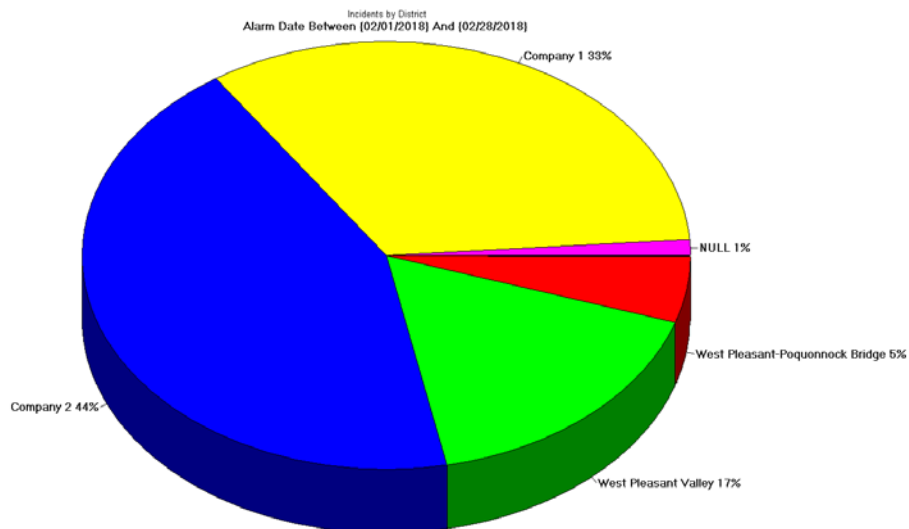
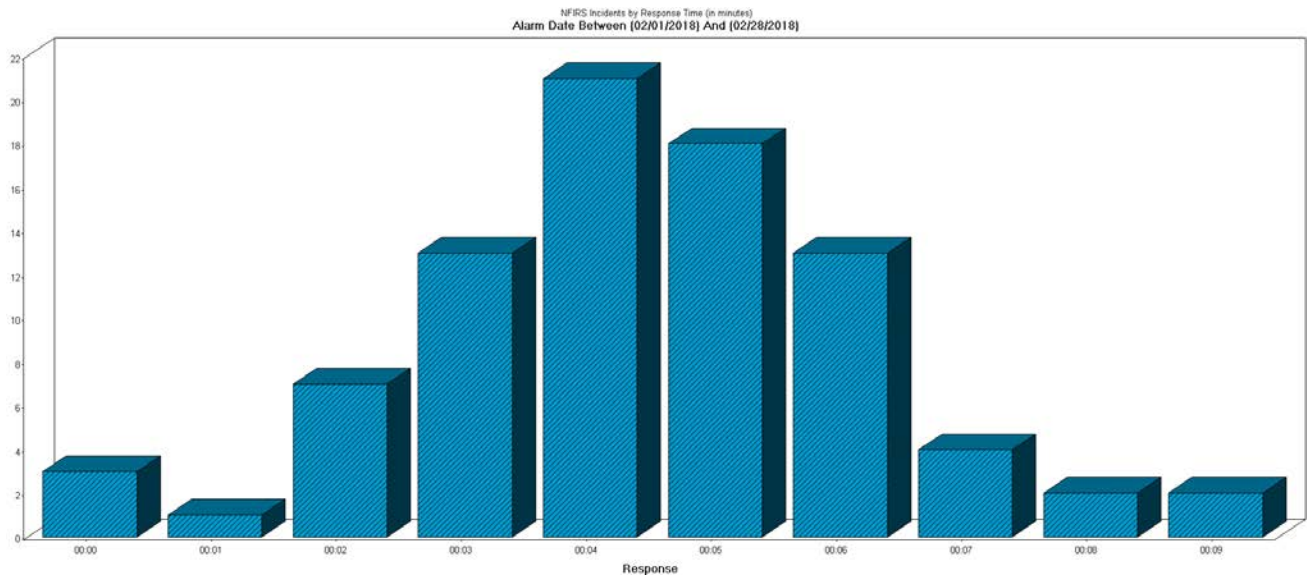
Count of Incidents by Alarm Hour
