10. A BY-LAW RESTRICTING THE CUTTING DOWN OR PLANTING OF TREES ON OR BETWEEN SIDEWALKS AND STREETS (MAY 26, 1904)

No person shall cut down any tree standing upon any street or highway in said city, nor set out any tree between the curb and sidewalk, without a permit from the mayor. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this section shall pay a fine of five dollars.
