

**36. AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE SPEED OF VESSELS IN PINE ISLAND BAY
AND IN THAT PORTION OF BAKER'S COVE WITHIN THE CITY OF GROTON
(JULY 8, 1963)**

Be it ordained by the Board of Mayor and Council of the City of Groton that pursuant to the authorization granted by the provisions of Section 15-127 and 15-136 of the General Statutes of Connecticut and by Article VI of the Charter of the City of Groton:

Section 1 - No vessel shall be operated in the waters of Pine Island Bay and in that portion of Baker's Cove within the territorial limits of The City of Groton at a rate of speed greater than five miles per hour.

Section 2 - Any person who violates the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00).

Section 3 - This Ordinance shall take effect of the first day of April, 1964, except upon a finding by the boating safety commission within the department of agriculture and natural resources of the State of Connecticut that an emergency exists which requires an earlier effective date.
