

## **CITY OF GROTON RESIDENT PARKING NOTICE FOR 2022**

**Residents of certain streets within the City of Groton are allowed to park in posted areas by displaying a residential parking sticker on the vehicle. Parking stickers are valid during the calendar year and are renewable by January 1<sup>st</sup> each year by providing the Police Department with an updated Application for Resident Parking form.**

**City of Groton Ordinance #215 approved July 5, 2016**

**The Application for Resident Parking form is available at the Police Department Dispatcher Desk or <http://cityofgroton.com/government-services/departments/city-of-groton-police/> under the Forms section. The application must be returned to the Police Department for approval. Once approved, the parking sticker will be placed on the vehicle by a representative of the Police Department. The one-time cost is \$20 for new applicants and no charge for renewals.**

**RESIDENTIAL PARKING PERMITS:** ALLEN ST, BAKER AVENUE, CHAPMAN ST, DENISON AVE, CUTLER ST, ELDERKIN/WEST ELDERKIN AVE, FOREST ST, GEORGE AVE, HAMILTON AVE, HIGH ST, HYNES AVE, LATHAM ST, LEDYARD AVE, MORSE AVE, PLEASANT ST, SLOCUMB TERR

**RESIDENT ONLY PERMITS and Visitor Passes:** (Only residents of these streets are permitted to park on the following streets and are allowed a designated number of visitor passes.) CENTRAL AVE, MEECH AVE, NICHOLAS AVE, SHORE AVE (from Tyler Ave to #212 Shore Ave), TRITON PL, TYLER AVE (between Eastern Point Road and Shore Avenue)
