WHEREAS, the City TIF Policy requires the City and Town Councils to refer the Draft Joint TIF District Master Plan to their respective Planning Commissions 90-days prior to holding a public hearing and said referral will be reviewed by the City Planning Commission no later than the Commission's May 21, 2019 meeting;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council refer the Draft Joint City and Town Tax Increment Financing (TIF) District Master Plan, dated March 13, 2019 to the City of Groton Planning and Zoning Commission as required under the City's TIF Policy dated September 4, 2018 and set a public hearing date to consider the adoption of said plan for September 3, 2109 at ____PM.
